Detective RALPH SALERNO, CIB, New York City Police Department, advised this office that ANTONIO CARILLO, New York top hoodlum, and DOMINICK MASSA were partners in the above company.

The records of CSNY-1 reflect that the above company registered in New York State on May 24, 1951, by DOMINICK MASSA, and was subsequently reregistered by MASSA and ANTHONY CARILLO on June 7, 1951. The records further reflected that captioned company went out of business on August 9, 1956.

Lieutenant WALTER CASEY, CIB, New York City Police Department, advised on February 27, 1957, that CARILLO was a constant companion, chauffeur, and bodyguard of MICHELE MIRANDA, New York Office top hoodlum, who attended the Apalachin meeting on November 14, 1957.
