INFORMANT

On 10/29/58 PCI TULLIO D. AVANZO wal advised SA WILLIAM J. WATRY that he is acquainted with the subject. He advised that the last he knew, the subject had a jewelry booth in the Conrad Jewelers, 205 Canal St., NYC, along with one JOSEPH "PAT" CAPPOS. He stated that he did not believe CAPPOS took part in his illegal dealings unless he was forced into it by the subject. He stated that TOMMY (LOBASSO, wa: "EEANSY", was always with the subject and did his leg work for him.

The PCI informed that the subject recently forced CAPPOS into giving CARMENALOMBARDOZZI, a top hoodlum of the NYO, a good deal of jewelry, but added LONEARDOZZI was in jail as a result of contempt before the NY State Crime Commission and did not pay for the merchandise. The informant advised that this jewelry was made up of stolen diamonds placed in new cettings.

The informant advised that SALLY EUPNS, an alias of SALVATORE GRANELLO, FEI # 2120006, is in the wederworld hierarchy, approximately the same as the late JOHNAY ROBERTS and gets a cut of all of the subject's deals.

He stated that BURNS in turn is subject to the authority of VITO/GENEVESSE and TONY BENDER, and that BURNS is the financial backer and puts up money when the subject buys large amounts of hot jewels.

DURKIN that SALLY EURNS VISITS the subject at his exchange daily, and that EURNS appears to have plenty of money, which money he believed to have been obtained through EURNS' Cuban gambling companion. He stated that he believes that EURNS is now a partner in the operation of the El Borracho Restaurant, 51 East 55th St., NYC, as he spends a good deal of time in that place. He stated that in the event that this was true, GEORGE LEVINE and the subject's brother, GUIDO PERRONE, would likewise have a hand in it.

It is noted that the photograph of the subject in possession of the bureau was taken in 1956 and bears an excellent resemblance of him.
