sent to DIA employee by subject containing extremely radical language, expressing regret that assassins failed to kill CHIANG Ching-kuo and stating that group's morale is very high now and in future "anything can happen." DIA determined that subject probably stayed in WDC at Shirlington House.

In view of subject's avowed propensity for violence, investigation to be conducted expeditiously and Secret Service kept advised.
