


NK 2461-C\* stated that on 7/8/65, PROVENZANO had a meeting at the Essex House Hotel in Newark with JOHN LARDIERE, aka Johnny Coke; JOSEPH PECORA, aka Joe Peck; and CHRIS FRANZBLAU, former USA in Newark and presently legal counsel for Local 560, International Brotherhood of Teamsters.

PROVENZANO stated that if CASTELLITO was successfully done away with, the individuals involved would share in a quarter of a million dollars which would be obtained from labor contracts. In addition, he promised BRIGUGLIO a business agent's job in Local 560.

Nothing was done in the matter for several months, according to the informant; and PROVENZANO called another meeting in his office at which he told those individuals that his trial in the DORN matter was coming up and the contract should be handled before the trial started.

According to the informant, the first attempt to kill CASTELLITO at his home did not succeed because CASTELLITO's wife and children were in the house at that time.

The informant stated that a short time later, CASTELLITO was lured to his summer home in Upstate New York where he was finally choked to death by BRIGUGLIO and CINNO.

On June 10, 1965, NK T-1 further advised that ARMAND FAUGNO was the driver of the murder car when WALTER GLOCKNER was shot to death in Hoboken, New Jersey, on May 24, 1963.

Informant stated that his murder was ordered by PROVENZANO because he felt that GLOCKNER would be called as a witness against him in the DORN case.

Informant stated that before GLOCKNER was killed PROVENZANO had ordered a "hit" on GEORGE PHILLIPS and also on RAY CARNEY, but later called off the hits.

It is noted that GLOCKNER, before his death, was a member of the "Green Ticket" which faction in Local 560 is in opposition to PROVENZANO. It is also noted that GEORGE PHILLIPS and RAY CARNEY are members of the opposing faction.

#### Legitimate Activity

By communication dated July 29, 1965, the Las Vegas Office advised that BILL CARTER, Las Vegas Teamsters President,

However, SALVATORE PROVENZANO is apparently not a member of the Cosa Nostra while SALVATORE BRIGUGLIO is.

On 12/9/64, informant stated that GENE CATENA has issued instructions to all members of his family who had anything to do with IBT matters to cooperate fully with ANTHONY PROVENZANO. Informant further advised that PROVENZANO was very upset with JAMES R. HOFFA, the International President of IBT, because HOFFA did not give him any support during the trial and attended no teamster's functions in New Jersey since PROVENZANO's conviction.

On 1/27/65, informant stated that GENE CATENA instructed PROVENZANO to send out an order directing all IBT Locals in New Jersey to leave all union organizing in Port Newark to the International Longshoremen's Association (ILA). In addition, PROVENZANO assured CATENA that the ILA is welcome to organize any company in the Port Newark area that is currently represented by the IBT.

On 2/8/65, informant advised that GERARDO CATENA met with PROVENZANO a few days before that date. PROVENZANO had apparently issued two conflicting IBT charters, one of which was to ROSARIO MOGAVERO, a close friend of CATENA. At this meeting CATENA made it plain to PROVENZANO that MOGAVERO was not to be harmed financially in any way.
