15. SUMMARY: (C) Source reports receiving information through "chain of Informants", which includes trusted individuals in CUBAN Armed Forces, relating to a security leak in the US. Allegedly, all saboteurs that are apprehended upon arriving in CUBA are arrested because u/1 individual in US alerts GOC regarding number of saboteurs, how, when and where they will arrive in CUBA. (NFIA)

A/H COMMENT: "Chain of Informants" include (1) friend of Source, who is employed by telephone company, (2) student, who is friend of Source and is a member of the firing squad at PRINCIPE FORT, HABANA CITY, and (3) member of CUBAN Navy stationed at SAGUA LA GRANDE, LAS VILLAS Province, who is brother of student. Apparently, naval personnel are original Sources.
