At 4:50 p.m., 5/20/65, [Michael Neff] Watch Officer, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), advised over the secure telephone network concerning an additional item which relates to information furnished earlier that there was to be a demonstration in Times Square, New York City, on the evening of 5/20/65. [Neff] said that the same source who furnished above-mentioned information had now advised that captioned individual, a member of the Legion of Baragua, and 8 other Cuban exiles were planning to enter the Russian Consulate in New York City and assault the occupants. This action reportedly planned to coincide with the demonstration at Times Square scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on 5/20/65. [Neff] also stated that this information could be passed on to local authorities in New York City and that CIA had already advised the State Department.
