"The Haitian Government has had to request of Charge" d'Affaires CURTIS the recall of three United States Embassy officials, JOHN W. WARREN, Military Attache, STANLEY D. MOSS, Cultural Attache, and JOHN HASEC ((C)), Political Counsellor. The State Department replied that the new Ambassador has been instructed to discuss this question after he presents his credentials, but that these officials will not be recalled unless they are declared personae non grata, and that the State Department will make reprisals.

Please explain to you know who the necessity of making a cleaning-out of the Embassy so that Haitian-United States relations may be resumed on a friendly and cordial basis.
