P5/723/8 THE FOLLOWING TELEX WAS RECEIVED FROM OUR "A" DIVISION HQ ON THE 3 DEC 75. QUOTE: "AT 21:55 HRS 3 DEC 75 A PHONE CALL WAS RECEIVED AT THE "A" DIV. DESK FROM A MALE PERSON WHO STATED HIS NAME WAS SAMUEL VOGEL AND HIS HOME ADDRESS 10 SUTTON PLACE 42ND ST. NEW YORK CITY NEW YORK. VOGEL ADVISED THAT HE HAD INFORMATION REGARDING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AND ALSO THE FUTURE ASSASSINATION OF TED KENNEDY. HE WISHED TO SEE A MEMBER OF THE RCMP IN THIS REGARD. VOGEL STATED HE WAS PRESENTLY STAYING IN ROOM 703 OF THE OTTAWA HILTON HOTEL. WHEN QUESTIONED AS TO THERE BEING NO HILTON IN OTTAWA HE INSISTED THAT WAS WHERE HE WAS AND HE WAS IN OTTAWA. STATED HE WAS FAMILIAR WITH THE STREETS IN OTTAWA BUT COULD NOT REMEMBER THE STREET THE HOTEL WAS ON. INDICES CHECKED NEGATIVE. CHECK MADE AT CHATEAU LAURIER HOTEL WHICH IS A HILTON CHAIN AND THEY HAVE NO RECORD OF SUCH PERSON STAYING AT HOTEL. CHECK MADE WITH OTHER MAJOR HOTELS IN OTTAWA WERE NEGATIVE. YOU MAY WISH TO CONFIRM AUTHENTICITY OF NEW YORK ADDRESS GIVEN. DURING PHONE CALL THE VOICE SOUNDED DISTANT AND THERE WAS CONSIDERABLE INTERFERENCE ON THE LINE." UNQUOTE.

IT WOULD BE APPRECIATED IF YOU MIGHT LIAISE WITH THE APPROPRIATE U.S. AUTHORITIES IN AN EFFORT TO OBTAIN ALL AVAILABLE BIOGRAPHICAL DATA CONCERNING THE SUBJECT AND ADVISE IF HE IS CONSIDERED A THREAT TO V.I.P.S.

ROYAL CANADIAN MOUNTED POLICE (RCMP) LIAISON OFFICE, WASHINGTON, DC, HAS ADVISED FBIHQ THAT ON DECEMBER 3, 1975, RCMP "A" DIVISION RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM A MALE PERSON WHO STATED HE WAS SAMUEL VOGEL, 10 SUTTON PLACE, 42ND STREET, NEW YORK, NY. CALLER STATED HE HAD INFORMATION REGARDING ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND ALSO A FUTURE ASSASSINATION OF TED KENNEDY. HE WISHED TO SEE A MEMBER OF RCMP AND SAID HE WAS STAYING IN ROOM 703 OF OTTAWA HILTON HOTEL. CALL SOUNDED DISTANT WITH CONSIDERABLE INTERFERENCE ON THE LINE. THERE IS NO HOTEL NAMED HILTON IN OTTAWA, BUT (S)

CHATEAU LAURIER HOTEL IS PART OF THAT CHAIN. NO RECORD LOCATED OF VOGEL AT THAT HOTEL OR OTHER MAJOR HOTELS IN OTTAWA. RCMP REQUESTED ALL AVAILABLE BIOGRAPHICAL DATA CONCERNING VOGEL AND DESIRE TO BE ADVISED IF HE IS CONSIDERED A THREAT TO VIP'S. (S)

FOR THE INFORMATION OF RECEIVING OFFICES OTHER THAN NEW YORK, REFERENCED TELETYPE CONTAINS SIMILAR INFORMATION REGARDING VOGEL RECEIVED DECEMBER 4, 1975, FROM US MILITARY ACADEMY, WEST POINT, NEW YORK, WHERE VOGEL HAD TELEPHONED ON DECEMBER 3, 1975.

USSS HEADQUARTERS ADVISES VOGEL'S REAL NAME IS IRVING GROSSMAN, AKA HENRY GROSSMAN, AND IRVING GROSSMANN. AS OF NOVEMBER 30, 1975, HE RESIDED AT 3536 HULL AVENUE, APARTMENT 1-E, BRONX, NEW YORK. HE IS A CAUCASIAN MALE; BORN AUGUST 30, 1940, AT NEW YORK CITY; 260 POUNDS; 6 FEET TALL. HE HAS A HISTORY OF MENTAL PROBLEMS AND IS CONSIDERED BEYOND REHABILITATION. IN 1965 HE ATTEMPTED TO BURN HIS HOUSE DOWN AND HE WAS VIOLENT IN THE PAST.

NEW YORK LOCATE AND INTERVIEW VOGEL REGARDING ANY INFORMATION HE MAY HAVE CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND ANY FUTURE ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY. NOTIFY USSS AND OBTAIN ANY INFORMATION REGARDING VOGEL. NOTIFY OTHER APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES. ADVISE FBIHQ, ALEXANDRIA, AND WFO, AND LEGAT, OTTAWA. SUTEL FOLLOWED BY LHM.
