William C. Rysie BZAN furnished a letter received 14 Jan 61, from a friend who was a member of a counter-revolutionary force under the leadership of subj (aka ALI). The group called "Brigada Internacional." The return address on the envelope was: Bob MCSTALLON, 2050 SW 60th St., Miami, Fla. (DBF-67)22, 2 Jan 61, Seattle)

Subj claimed to be a member of the anti-CASTRO group FRD. Subj had camp 40 miles from Miami with Max VILA Jr., in charge. Camp site deserted as of 31 Jan 1961. On 4 Feb 1961 a transport "Gil Rold" was stolen from Miami by group, some of whom were later arrested, and who had previously stayed at subj's Miami residence. Source reported subj on 26 Feb 61 had fled from what he described as unsuccessful attempt to get into Cuba on an invasion. Newspapers reported subj's US citizenship restored after he made appeal to FIDEL. Some of those were: Alex Burke, Bob McStallion, Dick Watley. Also a Ken Proctor was involved. (DBF-75627, 24 Apr 1961, Miami, Fla.) Also see DBF-75627, 22 Sept 61, 201-242256.

Subj Oct in July of 61 stated he headed an organization known as the International Anti-Communist Brigade claiming a membership of 5,000 men. Falsified source said this was with Subj the only member, and that it is nothing but a paper organ. Source DBF 24463, 17 Aug 61, 201-242256

Frank Florini has offered his services to Cuban FIDEL as a military advisor and planner for some future armed operation in Cuba. In Oct 61, was observed one day in Sept staying some days in Cuba. Source L. However subj is employed by FBI. Army Intel Report ID 2/152, 8/1, 3 Oct 1961)

For the time identity of the subject, several of the subjects of the radio "hans" in the past have been active in the subject's work on a yacht and also to other subjects in connection with the subject's equipment.

The State Dept. issued a certificate of citizenship to the subject in 1952. The checks dated 1-1-53 and 1-1-54 were issued to the subject.

Subj's pilot's certificate has been revoked by FAA and his appeal of the order expatriating him is still pending. One source stated subj has been inactive in anti-CASTRO matters recently, and another source said subj indicated he had a misunderstanding with Pedro DIAZ Lora. Said subj has not discussed his activities with him but did say recently there are too many groups and ideas working against CASTRO.

According to Neil Macaulay, who talked with subj in Pedro DIAZ Lora's office, subj trying to talk Diaz Lora into allowing him to have 50 men in the attack on Cuba. (talk took place sometime after 24 July 1954)
