name to which unid'd caller
intended to refer may have been
Manuel Garcia Gonzales.

Press reporter that Garrison
alleges that Garcia was one of
JFK's assassins. However, another
report from FBI N.O. 6/April 67
quote Dean Adams Andrews
as saying that Garcia doesn't
exist & that Andrews inserted the
name. CIA has no other record
of Garcia.

erratic & illogical. "It is evident
from her allegation (10 Dec 65) that
she had access to public source
info. which helped shape her
thinking. I have checked the
WC Master Index, the Oswald
file (both negative) and discussed
this matter w/ Charles Bounds
of the Mexican Desk. On the
basis of what I have read about
Elena Garro, and my knowledge
of the Oswald case, I would give
no credence to the info."

CIA records have info on one Bill Burley, U.S. A.F. Tech Serg. who was in Liberia in 1958 & may have been involved in nefarious activities. CIA refers FBI to Office of Special Investigation, USAF for ~~an~~ possible add'l info.

CIA info indicates that Burley had contact w/ people whose activities seem to have been ?able

These people are: John Babington, British soldier, German wife Irene - left Benghazi after March 1958

Henry Koleschek or Kolesuski (phonetic), German, born 1913-1918. In '58 he was an engineer in Benghazi.

Wife was English woman employed at NAAFI shop in Benghazi.

There is one report to the effect that
Guenther Giron (mentioned on p. 4 of BND
report) was under investigation in 63
by W. German authorities. Giron was
a journalist & corresp. for E. Berlin
radio station. Basis for outcome of
invest. not indicated in CIA files.
but his activities are believed have
little bearing on the invest.

CIA therefore concurs in BND's conclusion
that there is insufficient basis for
further investigation of the matter
