Available information indicates that Miss BUSTILLO, a Cuban ballet dancer, is about 20 years of age, and was one of the group of Cuban ballet dancers which recently made a tour of Europe. She reportedly has recently injured her foot and is not now dancing but is working as a secretary to Alicia ALONSO, the prima ballerina of Cuba.

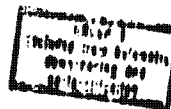

SUBJECT: Possible Opportunity to Recruit Agent in Place in Cuba

1. On Tuesday, 20 Dec 66, I received a call from Mr. Frank Bartes, former President of the Consolidated Railroads of Cuba. He is an alien but we have FBI approval to contact dated 14 Apr 61. []

2. He called on me primarily to tell me that his mother had arrived from Cuba and would be willing to talk to me.

3. In the course of our conversation Mr. Bartes told me that he had a cousin still living in Cuba named Alicia Cruz Bustillo, who is a ballet dancer associated with Alicia Alonzo, the prima ballerina of Cuba and also a well-known Communist. Bartes says that Alicia Bustillo is not a Communist and he and his family have been in contact with her.

4. Miss Bustillo, who is about 29 years of age, was one of the group of Cuban ballet dancers which recently made a tour of Europe. A group of these Cubans defected while the troupe was Paris, and this received wide publicity in our newspapers. Miss Bustillo, however, did not defect and continued on the tour and returned to Cuba with the group. According to Mr. Bartes, Alicia Bustillo has recently injured her foot and is not now dancing, but is working as secretary to Alicia Alonzo.

5. Mr. Bartes told me that he had planned to meet Alicia Bustillo in Paris and that she had agreed to meet him in Paris, but Mr. Bartes did not have the money to make the trip nor did he think that he would be able to obtain the necessary visa for the trip to Paris because of his status as a Cuban refugee.

6. Mr. Bartes says that Miss Bustillo has traveled all over the world with the Cuban ballet group and has visited most of the Communist countries including China. He feels quite certain that the Cuban group will make another tour and that he will be advised in advance of the date and itinerary. He feels quite certain that he will be able to arrange a meeting with Miss Bustillo provided the group visits a non-Communist country. He states that he has always been very close to Miss Bustillo whom he considers almost as a sister. He feels quite certain that she would be willing to help the US if she were approached in the proper manner, and he feels that the approach should be made through him because of his relationship and former closeness to her.

7. He says that he believes Miss Bustillo does not attempt to

leave Cuba because of the fact that her family is there and that she would not leave unless she could also get her family out. He believes that, despite the risk involved, she would be willing to act as an agent in place.

8. My relations with Mr. Barteaux have been very good, and I am inclined to believe what he says. However, this whole matter, of course, would have to be evaluated by the Clandestine Services.

9. There is one other matter I would like to mention in connection with Mr. Barteaux and that is that he served for two and a half months with a group of Cuban fliers in the Congo, as he holds a pilot's license. He did not tell me and I did not ask who the sponsors of this group were or what their duties were.

10. I pass this on for whatever it is worth and, if there is any further information which I can provide, I shall be glad to do so.

US citizen, a pathologist who has recently returned from Cuba where he spent five years in charge of rice production and associated research on a large rice plantation at Jaboata near the Camagney/Oriente border.

1. Just prior to my departure from Cuba on 26 May 60 I talked with a Vice President of one of Cuba's larger railroads. He occasionally goes on inspection tours of the railroad's facilities, and had just returned from an inspection of the company's spur lines in the Sierra Maestra region of Oriente province. He was accompanied at all times by a Cuban Army officer.
2. One of the spur lines in the Sierra Maestra ran into a restricted area. In this area my friend observed under construction numerous large concrete slabs, immediately adjacent to which were very tall towers of metal framework and wire construction. He says that these were not TV or radio antenna-type towers. From his very limited knowledge of the subject, i.e., the few pictures he has seen in magazines and newspapers of rocket launching sites, he said that these towers appeared similar to steel structures he has seen in pictures of rocket launching bases. He asked his Cuban Army escort what purpose the construction was to serve, and was told "It is not a good idea to ask too many questions where lightning might strike".
3. The concrete construction work was being handled by Mexican technicians.
4. During the construction of large storage tanks "for pure water" on Cayo Largo is widely known in Cuba, but few accept the fact that the storage tanks are for water. It is the consensus that these tanks are for fuel storage and will serve as a refueling base for submarines. I have flown over Cayo Largo and seen these tanks from the air. They do not look like water storage tanks to me.
5. I have heard that the tenth floor of the Havana Hilton is reserved for the Soviets. While staying there just prior to my departure from Cuba I noticed the elevators never stopped on the tenth floor. I inquired of elevator boys, the desk clerks, and even the assistant manager, why the tenth floor wasn't open to guests. I was told that there were no guests on the tenth floor, that it was not completed, and accommodated no guests. The next day my laundry was returned to me with several pairs of shorts which did not belong to me. The laundry is marked by room number at the Havana Hilton and the marks stamped in these shorts was a tenth floor room number.

SUBJECT: Possible Opportunity to Recruit Agent in Place in Cuba

1. On Tuesday, 20 Dec 66, I received a call from Mr. Frank Bartes, former President of the Consolidated Railroads of Cuba. He is an alien but we have FBI approval to contact dated 14 Apr 61. []

2. He called on me primarily to tell me that his mother had arrived from Cuba and would be willing to talk to me.

3. In the course of our conversation Mr. Bartes told me that he had a cousin still living in Cuba named Alicia Cruz Bustillo, who is a ballet dancer associated with Alicia Alonzo, the prime ballerina of Cuba and also a well-known Communist. Bartes says that Alicia Bustillo is not a Communist and he and his family have been in contact with her.

4. Miss Bustillo, who is about 29 years of age, was one of the group of Cuban ballet dancers which recently made a tour of Europe. A group of these Cubans defected while the troupe was Paris, and this received wide publicity in our newspapers. Miss Bustillo, however, did not defect and continued on the tour and returned to Cuba with the group. According to Mr. Bartes, Alicia Bustillo has recently injured her foot and is not now dancing, but is working as secretary to Alicia Alonzo.

5. Mr. Bartes told me that he had planned to meet Alicia Bustillo in Paris and that she had agreed to meet him in Paris, but Mr. Bartes did not have the money to make the trip nor did he think that he would be able to obtain the necessary visa for the trip to Paris because of his status as a Cuban refugee.

6. Mr. Bartes says that Miss Bustillo has traveled all over the world with the Cuban ballet group and has visited most of the Communist countries including China. He feels quite certain that the Cuban group will make another tour and that he will be advised in advance of the date and itinerary. He feels quite certain that he will be able to arrange a meeting with Miss Bustillo provided the group visits a non-Communist country. He stated that he has always been very close to Miss Bustillo whom he considers almost as a sister. He feels quite certain that she would be willing to help the US if she were approached in the proper manner, and he feels that the approach should be made through him because of his relationship and former closeness to her.

7. He says that he believes Miss Bustillo does not attempt to

leave Cuba because of the fact that her family is there and that she would not leave unless she could also get her family out. He believes that, despite the risk involved, she would be willing to act as an agent in place.

9. My relations with Mr. Berto have been very good, and I am inclined to believe what he says. However, this whole matter, of course, would have to be evaluated by the Clandestine Services.

9. There is one other matter I would like to mention in connection with Mr. Berto and that is that he served for two and a half months with a group of Cuban fliers in the Congo, as he holds a pilot's license. He did not tell me and I did not ask who the sponsors of this group were or what their duties were.

10. I pass this on for whatever it is worth and, if there is any further information which I can provide, I shall be glad to do so.

IN CONSIDERATION of my employment on the terms hereinafter set forth, I, **Francisco Barte** hereinafter called employee, hereby agree to the following conditions of employment:

1. That the term "employer" as used in this agreement shall be the Government of the Republic of the Congo, or any designated Department or Agency of said Government, or any Company or Agency that the said Government may designate.

2. That the service to be rendered by the employee under this agreement is to be an aircraft pilot, with no specific aircraft assignment.

3. That the term of employment under this agreement shall be for a period of one -1- year from **1 December** 1965. During the first six month term of this agreement, this agreement may be terminated by the employer at any time by thirty -30- days written notice in advance to the employee. During the last six month term of this agreement, this agreement may be terminated by either the employee or the employer by thirty -30- days written notice in advance to the other party.

4. That the employee shall be paid a basic, all inclusive, salary of Six Hundred -\$600.00- Dollars per month during the first six month. However, at any time during the tenure of this contract, that you are certified in writing by the Chief Pilot as Pilot in Command, your base salary will be increased to Eight Hundred -\$800.00- Dollars per month on the effective date of such certification. Additionally, you shall be paid an additional hourly rate per flying hour for all flight time in excess of sixty hours per schedule listed in amendment No. 2 of this contract. During the last six month term of this agreement, the employees base pay is increased an additional One Hundred -\$100.00- Dollars.

5. That the employee accepts the responsibility of the payment of all applicable taxes on all income earned by him under the terms of this agreement.

6. That the employee shall be furnished round trip tourist class air transportation costs from Miami, Florida, to destination, and return, and all other expenses directly relating to the travel involved. In the event at the termination of this agreement, the employee accepts employment with an employer other than the Government of the Republic of the Congo, the return transportation cost shall not be paid said employee. The return ticket shall be surrendered upon arrival at destination.

7. INSURANCE BENEFITS:

The employee shall be enrolled in the employer's group insurance program for which the employer pays the total premium. The insurance program provides death disability and medical benefits for the employee substantially as follows:

(1) \$10,000 payable in the event of the employee's death from any cause whatsoever during the term of this agreement.

(2) \$40,000 payable in the event of the employee's death from an accident arising out of and in the course of his employment, provided death occurs within one (1) year from the date of the accident. This benefit is in lieu of (1) above and is also reduced by any payments made under (3) below for the same accident.

(3) Temporary and permanent total and permanent partial disability benefits plus medical expenses for injuries or disablement to the employee arising out of and in the course of his employment. Said benefits are paid in accordance with the terms and limits of said insurance coverage and the maximum payable thereunder is \$40,000 for the same injury or disablement.

CONTINUANCE OF PAY AND ALLOWANCE

(1) In the event the employer determines the employee to be missing in action, the authorized designee of the employee will receive his basic salary plus an additional 25 per cent thereof for a period of up to six (6) months. If, at the end of the missing in action period, findings indicate that the employee is deceased, the appropriate insurance benefit provided for above will be paid to the employee's designated beneficiary.

(2) If the employee is captured and imprisoned, his authorized designee will receive the employee's basic salary plus an additional 25 per cent thereof for the duration of his confinement. In addition, the appropriate death benefit insurance provided for above will be paid if the employee dies during said confinement.

8. That the employee agrees to undergo a medical examination within five calendar days after his return.

9. That the employee promise he will not reveal in writing or any method, the activities, the sponsors, or any other facts that come to his attention by virtue of the performance of services under this agreement.

Amendment No. 2

Pay Scale

1. As employee is hired as a Pilot, you will receive \$600.00 base plus \$5.00 per hour over 60 hours actual flight time.

2. Once certified in writing as Pilot in Command, your base pay automatically is raised to \$800.00 per month - pro-rated to that portion of the month applicable. Additionally while acting as Aircraft Captain, all time over 60 hours flying is compensated at the rate of \$10.00 per hour. However, although certified as Pilot in Command, any time over 60 hours not considered command time (Co-Pilot), the hourly compensation is reduced to \$7.50 per hour.

Subject submitted job application form to [redacted] (principal agent, WITHRUSH, Miami, Florida) on 3 May 1965 for the purpose of consideration as a pilot in the WITHRUSH Project.

MOTIVATION AND CONTROL

Estimate Subject's primary motivation is financial. He has large family (wife and seven children) and has, in the past, been accustomed to high standard of living. Possibly his present occupation in real estate is not meeting his requirements for income and status. Also, he probably has continuing ideological interest in deposing Castro.

Subject was a leader in one of the anti-Castro resistance cells in Cuba prior to 1960. He was also a leader of an anti-Castro resistance group in New Orleans after emigration. His file indicates liaison with the FBI concerning this group's willingness to cooperate with the U.S. Government in operations against Cuba. In his connections with the FBI, he was extremely conscious of all aspects of security to the extent that he volunteered to be prosecuted for any breach of security or evidence of collusion. His record indicates no connection with any other national intelligence service.

2. LIST OTHER INDIVIDUALS (Agents, relatives, friends) WHO KNOW OF SUBJECT'S PRESENT INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES.

Probably wife and brother, Mario, and possibly some cousins residing in the Miami Area. However, Subject's file indicates attention to personal security in control of information concerning political affiliations and objectives.

Subject has no KUBARK training in clandestine operations. However while residing in Cuba he participated in resistance operations against Castro. His planning in sabotage above though, originality, and daring.

From 1947-1960 Subject acted as vice president and later president of family railroad and agriculture enterprise. He made a commercial success of these operations which were later confiscated by the Castro Regime. He lost a large personal fortune as did other close members of his family. He was an ardent anti-Castro, anti communist leader of resistance groups both in Cuba and in New Orleans.

Subject previously used his own private aircraft in managing his commercial interests. It is hard to judge from the Subject file precisely why he has applied for a flying position in the Congo for reasons other than obvious financial aspects. Further, his 19 May 1965 application to Robert Medall indicates a lack of stability and solvency in his present position as a railroad executive. Subject has a wife and two young children.



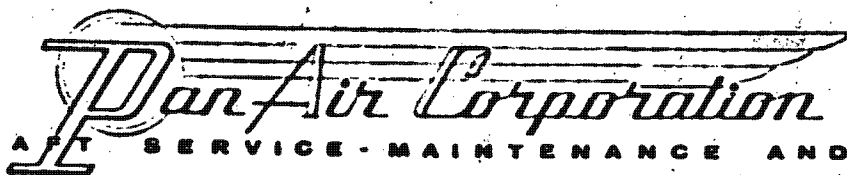
