A Provisional Operational Approval is granted for the use of this Subject as set forth below.

A Provisional Operational Approval issued by CI Staff grants the same authority, on a temporary basis, for the use of an individual as the authority granted in an Operational Approval unless otherwise specified by CI/OA. It is based, however, only on preliminary file checks and investigation and is subject to a further final review when all investigation is completed.

PRQ is issued for contact with Subject to explore her interest in the CIA and information of operational interest in the Latin American and possibly other areas.

In dealing with this Subject it should be recalled that her past association with CIA has been widely blown through broad publicity.

It is recommended that Subject be kept in a strong, and the case to be closed and will avoid emotional involvement with the Subject.

The case officer should be fully briefed on Subject's background and her past and recent problems. History of particular note is her involvement with John Rabe, PRQ cover respondent in Mexico and on CI - a agent who has been tried to compromise while he was serving a tour in Moscow.

Please forward PRQ Part II.

To process the Operational Approval, full information (completed PRQ Parts I and II) must be submitted as soon as possible and not later than six (6) months from this date. An Operational Approval will follow when all investigation is completed and upon the receipt of satisfactory PRQ Parts I and II. Cancellation must be requested if use of Subject by interested Divisions ceases.

DOD has requested approval to contact of Viola June COBB (LISCHY/1) and explore her access to targets and information of operational interest in the Latin American and possibly Cuban context.

She was originally recruited in June 1960 for use in Cuba, moved to Mexico City in June 1961, where she was effectively used in reporting on the Central American leftist field until June 30, 1966, when she was terminated because she had lost her access to the target group because of close association with KENNEDY, who publicly defected from the CP, and because of widespread rumors that she was in the pay of CIA. She is now in New York.

Among her numerous intimate relationships, she was the mistress in late 1962 to 1964 of John KENTON, a communist in Mexico. One cable reference indicates that KENTON may have been recruited by the Soviets during a Moscow tour. I understand that you had some interest in KENTON several years ago. I do not feel that we should proceed further on the approval request without touching base with you to determine whether you have information on KENTON which would preclude our approval of LISCHY's use.

<p>Mr. Hunt, DC/CI, stated on above date that he has no information on Rettie which would preclude the Agency's use of LICOOKY-1. He stated that Rettie is a weak character, now remarried, who is an agent of MI-6. On his Moscow tour the Soviets tried to compromise him. He reported the matter to British Intelligence, which, fearing that he may have been brought under Soviet control, made ^{made} such inquiry as possible into the problem, including an interrogation in depth of Rettie. They never came up with any evidence that he was brought under Soviet control.</p>

4. She was given a post office box address to use to contact the Station in the event that she does return to Mexico and feels it necessary to do so. But no commitment was made to her regarding any future contact or payment for information.

5. She was previously told that the telephone number of the KUBARK office is listed in the directory and she could call that office if contact were necessary while she was in the United States. She asked if that would still be the case and was told that it was but only to attempt such contact for an important or urgent matter. But since she tends to liberally apply importance to a wide variety of events and subjects, and since she is likely to be short of money shortly after arriving, it would not be surprising if she did try to establish such contact.

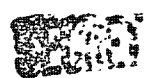

1. LICOOKY-1's efforts as described in reference have substantial merit and some potential particularly if the Station can find a way to tie them in with the LIREAM effort in the intellectual field.
2. LICOOKY-1 certainly is to be commended for her effort in getting writers both of the right and left such as Carlos PELLICER Camara to join the AEM. From a KUBARK standpoint the most interesting contact is the one with PELLICER because he has been the reported force behind the COMES/CLE effort in Mexico.
3. Although her assigned tasks as reported in para 7 a, b and d of the LILINK memo do not entail making her witting of other Station assets engaged in MHSPAWN Ops among the intellectuals, an amendment to her OA is required, and one has been requested. If her efforts progress to the point where she might be able to influence leftist writers in their efforts to establish the CLE in Mexico (para 7 c of LILINK memo) Headquarters should be forwarded your ideas on why and how LICOOKY-1 should be used as an active MHSPAWN agent, and another amendment will be required for this role.
4. ANDRIETTE will discuss this operation with the Station during his TDY.
5. In view of the restricted OA which confines KUBARK's association with LICOOKY-1, it is important that Headquarters remain aware of any unusual activity in her personal life which might affect her security or the granting of amendments to her OA for individual operations. Therefore, we would appreciate your keeping us informed on a more timely basis of any undertakings such as the recruitments for membership in the AEM described in reference.

1. The first steps to organize the Mexican Writers' Association (AEM - Asociación de Escritores de México) were taken in February of 1964 after Bartolome Costa-Amic and the Zaplana Bookstores published a proposal in the metropolitan newspapers, offering to establish a new series of library prizes and urging the Mexican writers to join an association that could provide material benefits for its members. The first meeting of the AEM was held on 11 August 1964. For some time the AEM remained as insignificant as other similar organizations which had been organized from time to time, such as the Society of Literary Authors and The Society of Friends of Mexican Books which never achieved any effectiveness or respectability. Mexico's established and well known writers have always shunned these organizations.
2. LICCOCKY-1 became interested in the AEM through her friendship with Costa-Amic and saw the possibility of building the AEM into an organization which would include the middle of the road and right wing authors who had been systematically boycotted since the Lázaro Cárdenas' regime when Narciso Bassols, a member of the Communist Party, was Minister of Education.
3. LICCOCKY-1 began a one man campaign of recruiting relatively well known right wing writers who could not be considered mediocre or nonentities. As LICCOCKY-1's campaign began to succeed it became easier to recruit the more important writers of Mexico covering the whole political spectrum. In October of 1964, LICCOCKY-1

persuaded Carlos Pellicer Cárara, well known Mexican poet, to join the AEM. It then became easier to get other well known writers to join. In all LICOCKY-1 recruited about 80 of the well known Mexican writers to come into the AEM. At this time LICOCKY-1 knew nothing of the European Community of Writers (COMES - *Soviet inspired according to sources* Comunità Europea degli Scrittori) or plans to form a Community of Latin American Writers (CLE - Comunidad Latinoamericana de Escritores).

4. LICOCKY-1 has been appointed to the Board of Directors of the AEM which permits LICOCKY-1 to attend all Board Meetings and she is relied upon to do all details of organization and planning the AEM projects to assist the Mexican writer which is the ultimate objective of the AEM.

5. In this work LICOCKY-1 has developed friendships with the leaders of the AEM including Pellicer and Juan Rulfo, both of whom were Mexican delegates to the COMES Conference held in Geneva, Switzerland during the winter of 1965. Pellicer has invited LICOCKY-1 to his home and confers with her on AEM problems, usually once a week. She has free entrance to Rulfo's office at the Instituto Indigenista and he has visited LICOCKY-1's apartment.

6. The Station hopes that through LICOCKY-1 the AEM can be used to defeat any attempts by COMES through its affiliate CLE to form

a Unity of Writers (UE - Unidad de Escritores) in Mexico as well as sabotage the CLE Congress to be held in Mexico in 1963.

7. To this end, one of LICOCKY-1's principal objectives is to solidify her acceptance in the AEM and she has been given the immediate tasks of:

- a. Preparing complete assessments and personality data on all of the influential AEM leaders.
- b. Determining LICOCKY-1's influence on them as a basis for;
- c. Using the AEM, when the time comes, to keep Pellicer and Rulfo from forming the UE affiliate in Mexico, preparatory to the coming CLE Congress.
- d. LICOCKY-1 is to continue her work in the AEM and to try to become a close confidant of Pellicer, Rulfo and other influential leaders of the AEM.

8. The Station plans to closely watch the development of the AEM and the plans and activities of Pellicer, Rulfo, Benjamín Carrión, Miguel Angel Asturias and others who may participate in planning for the forthcoming CLE Congress.
