| <p>Action Required: See paragraph three</p> <p>1. On 13 May 1961 AMT-63 reported that he talked with Subject, who arrived in Miami on 9 May 1961 from Cuba. The following information was disclosed in the interview:</p> <p>BRUNSCHEID said he had worked in the underground in Cuba and was closely associated with the FRR in December 1950 when that Service began to organize under the direction of a young man who reportedly was trained in PBRIMS for the purpose of organizing that Service within Cuba. BRUNSCHEID further stated that while working with the FRR he travelled to Oriente Province with this young "organizer" for the purpose of uniting the revolutionary groups active in that Province.</p> <p>BRUNSCHEID said that he was in charge of collecting information from sources in Pinar del Rio and passing it to the W/T operators who then forwarded it to PBRIMS.</p> <p>After the capture of AMT-63, chief of the underground in Cuba, BRUNSCHEID became the secretary of the new chief, and maintained this position until 17 April when the mass arrests and the round-up of several of his colleagues forced him to go into hiding. He sought refuge in the French Embassy in Havana, and although this Embassy does not have the right to grant asylum, he was permitted to remain in hiding there as a guest of the embassy. When he was able to leave for PBRIMS, the French Ambassador personally escorted him to the plane.</p> <p>BRUNSCHEID believes that the underground in Cuba has been virtually put out of business by the wholesale arrests throughout the country. He said the situation of the members of the underground who have not been arrested is desperate, as they have no place to hide.</p> <p>BRUNSCHEID told AMT-63 he was very interested in working for the cause in any way possible. He speaks three languages (Spanish, French and English). He also holds two passports (Cuban and French) as his father is a Frenchman.</p> | | | | | |

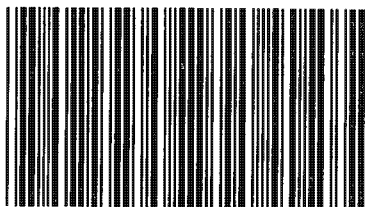

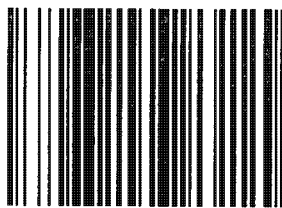

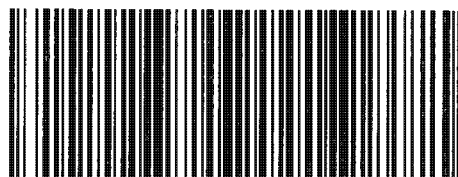
