OCCURRENCE:

Wm Broe said that the Cuba section became part of the Western Hemisphere Div in 1965 when Desmond Fitzgerald became C/WH. (Then, when Fitzgerald moved to DDP, Broe became C/WH.) In 1970 David Phillips was head of Cuban operations. Before him: **Tom Flores**; before that, John Hart; Larry Sternfield also served as head of Cuban operations. ~~The Cuba section was broken down into CA, FI, G para-military. The Miami Station was under military cover.~~
