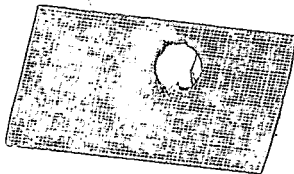

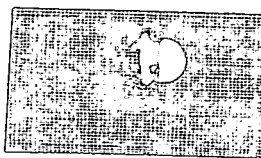

On 6/6/61, former PCI CAMILLE NAFFAH advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III as follows:

He has heard rumors recently among Pittsburgh area gamblers to the effect that ARCHIE NELSON wants to sell the Phoenix Motel, U. S. Route 22, Monroeville, Pa., for some unknown reason. NELSON's recent heart attack is believed to have been phoney and staged to prepare a plausible reason for him to sell a profitable business. The same gamblers have said they understand that "the boys from New Kensington" are interested in buying the Phoenix Motel. To informant, "the boys from New Kensington" can only refer to SAM and KELLY MANNARINO personally or someone "fronting" for them.

Pittsburgh will remain alert to the possible sale of this motel and, if sold, the identities of the purchasers.

BOTH SUBJECTS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.
