- (S) Forson Marfa (File: 22D127-19) is the OSI cover name for a dangle (5) operation which has been directed mainly against the Cuban Intelligence 🗲 Service (CubIS) since May 1967. Except for a recent indication from an (5) FBI source that a Cubis representative assigned to the Cuban Mission to CS. the United Nations (CubMUN) showed an interest in Subject) there has been no positive input to indicate CubIS interest. However, (intelligence information developed by your agency has showed that the CubIS has displayed intelligence interest in at least two Air Force bases in Florida, MacDill AFB and Homestead AFB.
- (S) In view of the known CubIS interest in the above bases, the apparent future of the Marfa dangle operation, and the present lack of LS. any viable operation involving USAF assets, we would like to determine your feelings concerning initiating an induced operation against the CubIS. [65] We believe that a young, low ranking airman, Cuban born or of Cuban descent, who is or could be in the future stationed at Homestead AFB or MacDill AFB would fit our purposes. The asset, motivated by either monetary and/or (5) ideological considerations, would walk into the CubMUN and offer a document for sale. A more detailed scenario would be developed once an asset is identified and recruited. \ < 5

3. (S) The objectives of this operation would be to determine the CubIS EEIs as they apply to USAF installations, the degree of cooperation between the CubIS and the Soviet Intelligence Service, and the techniques the CubIS would use in handling USAF espionage assets.
