On February 16, 1966, NY 3610-C-TE advised
Special Agents CHARLES G. DONNELLY and PAUL G. DURKIN,
that as yet he has not obtained the telephone number of
CHARLIE WHITES telephone answering service, but expects
to in the very near future.

In conversation with the informant, WHITE told him that JOE STASSI's son, JOSEPH, JR., was arrested because of a letter which was found in his apartment. However, WHITE said that as yet STASSI has not been caught. It is obvious that WHITE does not know that STASSI was apprehended several weeks ago in Miami, Florida.

For some weeks, WHITE has been requesting the informant to install a gadget on his telephone so that he will be able to record all of his incoming and outgoing telephone calls. Informant has stalled WHITE, but said that eventually, at his insistence, he may put the device on his telephone. According to the informant, this device acts as a transmitter, which means that all of his conversations would be broadcast and monitored by the use of the gadget, as the informant referred to as a "freak". It is pointed out that the agents did not request this procedure and it was further stated to the informant that they were not interested in utilizing a "freak" in order to monitor any of WHITE's telephone conversations.

Periodic spot checks of subject's residence during the investigative period were made by SAS PAUL G. DURKIN and CHARLES G. DONNELLY.

Information from the NY Telephone Company was made available by OSKAR G. DANIELSON, Security Supervisor, NYC.

In a separate communication, leads to identify and interview subscribers residing in offices not receiving this report have previously been set out.
