SOURCE AND APPRAISAL

FORMER LATIN AMERICAN MILITARY OFFICER WHO AT ONE TIME RESIDED IN HAITI AND THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC. HE STILL MAINTAINS FAIRLY CLOSE FRIENDSHIPS WITH OFFICIALS OF THESE COUNTRIES. SOURCE IS A TRAINED REPORTER AND HIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN RELIABLE IN THE PAST.

1. PAUL TOUSSAINT AND FERMIN JOSEPH HAVE CONCLUDED THAT THEY HAVE LOST CONTROL OF THE ARMS THAT WERE TRANSPORTED TO MIAMI BY ROLANDO MASFERRER ROJAS, CUBAN EXILE INVOLVED IN THE HAITIAN EXILE OPERATION PREVIOUSLY SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 1964. THE ARMS ARE IN THE CARE OF ANTONIO ROJAS MASFERRER IN MIAMI AND MASFERRER WILL NOT AUTHORIZE THEIR RETURN TO THE HAITIAN EXILES BECAUSE HE IS AFRAID THAT THEY WILL USE THEM TO LAUNCH AN OPERATION WITHOUT HIS PARTICIPATION.

2. MASFERRER IS DISGUSTED WITH TOUSSAINT AND JOSEPH FOR HAVING CUT HIM OUT OF THE OPERATION. AT ABOUT 11:00 P.M.
