I. Introduction.

1. This is a report of an inquiry into alleged indiscretions of Mr. [redacted], Chief of Station, Ciudad Trujillo.

2. This inquiry was conducted in Ciudad Trujillo between the dates of 11 and 15 March 1957, by representatives of the IIR Staff and WH Division.

II. Allegations of Mr. William PAWLEY, former U.S. Ambassador.

3. On 25 February 1957, Mr. William PAWLEY, former U.S. Ambassador to Brazil, in conversation with the Director had stated, in part, that Mr. [redacted] was "...a busybody and an extremely conceited boy...he wants to be in the middle of everything and he talks to everybody in the world...he is always trying to milk me for information because he sees I am from the government and he is trying to get information out of me...I have seen few people who are less discreet...I believe that he is not a man who can evaluate a situation on its merits...not only the Dominicans are scared to death of him but all the Americans are scared of him, I am scared of him, and I am afraid to talk to the guy and that isn't the type of man you want in CIA".
