David SALVADOR, secretary-general of the Confederacion de Trabajadores Cubanos, TDCS-3/ has ordered Subj., who was instrumental in defeating the Communists in several bus unions shortly after the overthrow of former dictator Fulgencio BATISTA on 1 January 1959, to make a pact with the Communist leader of the Pcs Workers' Union.

El Estado, Bogota newspaper carried interview with subj who accused [redacted] of signing arms to Colombian guerrillas.
