Since around January 1960, Station Mexico has been involved in 11 defections in recruitments" of Cuban officials, mostly from the Cuban Embassy in Nortice City. The most important of these was Jose PARDO Llada, who was not an official and not from the Embassy, but was next to Castro himself, the most popular voice among the Cuban masses. An unbuccessful "approach" was made to Rolando Cityla Secacia, a Cuban attident leader. The Station currently has one penetration of land leader as a veteran Station agent in close and friendly contact with another Embassy official. In addition, the Station is now following up the pession of defection of a well-known official of the Confederacion de Tratifador le Cuba Revolucionaria (CTCR).

In addition, the Station made an unsuccessful "approach" to Relatio CUBEIA Segades, titular head of the Students in Cuba at that time. The "approach" consisted of a "friendly" talk between a Station Came Officer, a mutual friend of CUBEIA and CUBEIA when the last-mentioned was visiting in Mexico. While CUBEIA did not pick up the opportunity at that time, he apparently did not report the inclosed to his superiors and the groundwork may have been laid for similar action in the fiture.

Three of the "recruitments" were of importance. LITALUS-3 planted the original LIERODE microphones. LIOOZE-1 headed the G-2 section for a time gaid LITALUL-3 was for a not inconsiderable period of time actually de facts collect of the Embassy LITALUT-6 furnished little of value. The term "recruitment" has been placed in quotes to indicate that none of these agents was ideal from the st adpoint of contral, except LITALUS-3, who, although low level, proved out in the full est sense of a recruitment. Most of the recruitments were effected by proven Station assets, LITAMIL-1 LITAMIL-2 and LITALUS-2. LITAMIL-3 is still active, alt ough he no longer works within the Embassy CLITALUS-3 developed an Embassy Tracing 24 operation now handled by LITAINT-2 and LITAMIL-3 has been instrumental in recruiting

in 1961, and although arrangements had been made for him to report by SW, the charnel has never been activated at his end, in spite of the fact that AMSEVER-3 was sent in to Cuba as a legal traveler to ascertain why not. Apparently LIOOZE-1 prefers not to run any risks inside of Cuba itself.

Current Situation

With regard to the Station's present defection and recruitment activities, the Station has one penetration LITAMIL-7, a rather timid personality whose major value is that he is inside the Cuban Embassy with the operational advantages basically implied. He has little access to confidental information but is able to bring out propaganda, official Cuban letterheads and the like. There is probably little hope that LITAMIL-7 will turn out to be another LITAMIS-3. The Station's best chance of setting worthwhile information from the Embassy of in the near future seems to be AMSTET-11 who works in the same section as AMSTOKE-11 did fermerly. While assessments of AMSTET-1 have not yet indicated that a proper pitch can be made to him, he is for all practical purposes already furnishing much information of value to LIMASK-1, a veteran KUBARK agent who is in intimate contact with nim.

Current Station defection targets include the Cuban Ambassador nimsels, who has many times been reported to be susceptible, and Odon ALVAREZ de la Campa, an important official of the CICR in Cuba, who reportedly has sent out messages N. Ethat he wishes to defect. The Station is now trying to get more information in the latter case.
