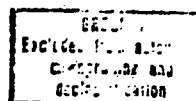
**SUBJECT: Miguel Angel DIAZ Isalgue (A 11 264 049)

It is requested subject be issued Form I-512, Reentry Document, under the name of Juan Hidalgo ELIZONDO Romano to permit his return to the United States. In this connection, there are enclosed two (2) photographs of subject.

Travel information will be submitted prior to subject's departure from the United States to permit control of Form I-94, Arrival/Departure Record Card. Your Service will be advised in advance of subject's return to the United States.
