The Sunday Edition of THE NEW YORK TIMES of 6 June 1966 contained the attached clipping "Warren Report on Assassination Challenged Again" in which mention is made that VIKING PRESS is bringing out 15,000 copies of a book based on a Cornell University Master's thesis "Inquest" by Subject.

A search of Security Indices and sources available in the Agency Library has been unproductive which is not surprising that EPSTEIN is thirty-one years of age and must have spent about the last eight years as a university student at Cornell and Harvard Universities.

The book has the name of an Agency employee who hasbeen concerned with the Oswald case, namely Ray ROCCE. Due to this surfacing of an Agency employee Edward EPSTEIN and his sources are of importance to the Agency.
