**SUBJECT: GORNICKI, Wieslaw****ALLEGATION:**

Wieslaw GORNICKI, a Polish Journalist, is the author of a long article on the GARRISON investigation in "Polityka", No. 1 (566), Year XII, Warsaw, 6 January 1968.

**CIA CONNECTION:**

Subject was granted an OA in April 1963 for use as a source of operational information by ER/XOB in Poland, under Project OBERON. In November 1964 CMC's were conducted to bring Subject's case up-to-date as he was being considered for possible recruitment in place. Subject was a Polish Press Agency Correspondent.

**OS INDICES RESULTS:**

Subject's file reflects an OA as set out above and CMC's in January 1965.

Subject was born 6 February 1931 at Warsaw, Poland and is a Polish citizen. His permanent address in 1964 was listed as UL Saoy Zolborskie, M. 17, Warsaw, Poland. At the time he was residing at 45-37 163rd Street, Flushing, New York and was employed as a United Nations Polish Press correspondent.
