| <p>On 1 December ⁰¹[VALIN/6] said that Soviet Consul Golub had told ⁰¹[VALIN/1] that a western agent, who crossed the Finnish-Soviet border near Instra on 18 May 1959 had been arrested and was being held by the Soviets. Golub did not reveal the name of the agent, but said that he had been trained in Austria. ⁴⁻¹To the [Station]'s knowledge, there have been no REDSOX missions run via Finland by KGB since 1953.
