1. On the evening of 10 September VACCINE/1 and his wife were at Branley's home for dinner. It was supposed to be purely a social evening, and very little business was discussed. 01 However, VACCINE/1, who has been back from his five-week summer vacation for only one week, could not resist the urge to bring up the VAPID-Torreyson case. 02 He said that he had read the interrogation report which had been prepared by one of his men and had subsequently talked to COLUB on COLUB's initiative. COLUB had called him and invited him to lunch, and they had met last Thursday. 01 From VACCINE/1's account it appeared that COLUB had described the incident at the airport quite factually, but 01 VACCINE/1 placed very little credence in the accuracy of the account. He said that in view of the fact that the six American athletes were left behind to await visas, he could well understand that Torreyson had needed VAPID to 02 the point of consperation. He does not believe that anything further will come of the case. Certainly the Ministry of Interior plans to forget about it unless a new protest comes from the Soviet Ambassador.

2. Incidentally, COLUB told VACCINE/1 that VAPID had behaved stupidly in the whole affair and has been recalled to the Soviet Union. (VACCINE/1 01 says he has already departed.) COLUB also remarked that VAPID is a worried 02 and upset man. Apparently the Soviets, or at least COLUB, do not believe VAPID's full story, according to VACCINE/1. 01 The reason for this doubtfulness 02 is that when the sleeping incident occurred, VAPID had been speaking English 02 to Torreyson. This report was evidently confirmed by the baggage leader who witnessed the carrying. COLUB thought it strange that VAPID, who speaks 02 Finnish well, should not use that language in speaking to Torreyson, who also has a fair command of Finnish.
