She further stated that as an anateur journalist she hoped to cover a story, previously unreported in the West, and also trace the case histories of one or more of the soldiers formerly stationed in Austria who were then being demobilized. She identified her newspaper outlet as the Morth American Mewspaper Alliance, 229 West 13rd Street, New York City.

- 5. On October 21, 1955, the Department of State authorised the Embassy to validate subject's passport for travel to Russia providing Soviet permission to enter that country was granted. On Movember 17, 1955, subject presented a letter from the Russian Embassy, London, which notified her that her visa to Russia had been received.
