These photographs have been provided to KUBARK for our internal use only, except for permission to show them to [COGIANT] for their possible identification of the individuals depicted thereon. The circumstances under which the photographs were found precluded the establishment of whether they were the possessions of or taken by MARTIN or MITCHELL, although the backgrounds and the individuals appearing in the photographs suggest that they were taken in Japan, presumably at some unknown date between 1-51 and mid-1-55. For convenience in future reference in event of identification of any of these individuals, the pictures have been labeled A through D.
