ACCETA-1 reported to case efficer, that several days ago he had a discussion with Manolo RAY. Case officer ashel if the discussion centered around the "important announcement" RAY is supposed to make. AMBERA-1 felt it might because RAY said that shortly he was going to propose that for total FORDMEN unity a military justa be composed of all the counterrevolutionary groups in Mismi, each having a vote in the junta. Also that a group of PERDEN advisors would be formed as a separate entity but contiguous to the PERDEN uniffly effort. These advisors would be composed of former professional men of all categories (lawyers, economists, engineers, etc.) but such group would not have a vote in the junta nor would they control the junta.

ANDERA-1, assumed from RAY's conversation, that should such a proposal by RAY obtain support, the junta would then ask for US support. If they would not receive US help, they would search elsewhere. It wasn't clear in what manner they expected US help, i.e., naterial and or manpower or just matérial.

No doubt RAY's upcoming announcement has been discussed in the PERUMEN community, because AMICE-8 asked AMBUD-1 what he thought of the proposal. AMBUD-1 was reported to have said he didn't like it and it would further divide the PERUMEN element in the .
