SUBJECT: Administrative Plan for ARMB Activity - ARMB

I. OVERVIEW

1. KUBARK is supporting a revolutionary organization to further the aims of the United States in its efforts to combat Communism in PERU.

II. INSTRUMENTALITY

2. The Executive Committee of ARMB consists of high-ranking PERUVIAN elites, politicians and business leaders, all of whom are anti-Communists, generally known as opposed to hold positions in the new government when Communism is defeated in PERU. KUBARK support is in the form of a subsidy for political and psychological action.

VII. BACKGROUND

3. ARMB serves as a "front" for KUBARK supported political and psychological action, and as a rallying point for a limited political alliance in the country of elites. Funds introduced by KUBARK are for a two-fold purpose, i.e., (a) to support the efforts of ARMB and (b) to pay dependents of non-retirees a monthly stipend. KUBARK is the largest contributor in support of this group.

IV. PARALLEL HISTORY

4. The present history of ARMB is approximately 1950-1951, 100,000 month while in 1951 it was with the name of the group. The group consists of 500,000-600,000 in a very few administrative support of the organization, and is a very important part of the group and appears operational appears.

V. RECOMMENDATION

5. In order to authorize JHET to make the above mentioned out-of-pocket payments, it is recommended that the attached Plan be approved. The Concurrence Sheet indicates that the Plan has been coordinated with interested Staffs and Divisions of KOBARK.
