RE: NEW YORK TELETYPE TO BUREAU, APRIL 26, 1964.

NEW YORK POLICE DEPARTMENT (NYPD) IS CURRENTLY CONDUCTING AN INVESTIGATION OF THE MURKIN CASE AND HAS ADVISED THAT THE INDIVIDUALS NAMED IN THE ATTACHED LIST WERE OBSERVED AT THE MURKIN RESTAURANT ON APRIL 22, 1964.

THE INDIVIDUALS NAMED IN THE ATTACHED LIST WERE OBSERVED AT THE MURKIN RESTAURANT ON APRIL 22, 1964, AT APPROXIMATELY 11:30 P.M. THE INDIVIDUALS WERE OBSERVED IN THE RESTAURANT FOR A PERIOD OF APPROXIMATELY 30 MINUTES. THE INDIVIDUALS WERE OBSERVED IN THE RESTAURANT AT THE FOLLOWING ADDRESSES:

PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED INDIVIDUALS HAVE BEEN ADVISED THAT ANY "IDENTITY" SHOULD BE PROVIDED BY PREPARATORY BUREAU OF THE FBI. THE INDIVIDUALS WERE ADVISED THAT IF IDENTIFICATION IS NOT PROVIDED, THE INDIVIDUALS WILL BE CONSIDERED AS SUSPECTS IN THE MURKIN CASE.
