As stated in Madrid letter of 5-10-62, pertinent information regarding subject was furnished the local station of CIA

Reference Miami letter to the Bureau reflects that subject proceeded to Mexico prior to the time Russian official MIKOYAN arrived in Mexico from Cuba and was in contact with JACK/STEWART who Miami informant stated was reported to work for the U. S. Embassy in f Mexico City. FIt is the recollection of Legat, Madrid, that JACK STEWART was an agent of CIA assigned to the American Embassy in Mexico and handled Cubans

It would appear that CIA is completely aware of subject's activities and possible intentions to defect
