ALERT IN EASTERN NAVAL DISTRICT RELAXED, 23 NOVEMBER

As a result of the death of President KENNEDY, the Eastern Naval District of Cuba was placed on an alert at 2044Z on 22 November by Bases, headquarters for that district. ((A))

At 2237Z on 23 November, the alert was relaxed a certain degree by Bases; instructions were passed to Santiago de Cuba, a subordinate, to give leave to 25 percent of their personnel for the 22nd and 24th and that further orders would be forthcoming on 25 November 1963.

COMMENT: The authorization to grant leave to personnel is an indication that the alert is somewhat relaxed and we note that further instructions would be issued on Monday, 25 November, indicating that a nonurgent view has been adopted for the situation by Cuban Naval authorities in the Eastern Naval District.
