Vaivada entered duty 1 June 1949 as a contract agent. In Costa Rica from June 1949 - Aug. 1953. where his record outstanding - included successful handling high level Communist Party penetration. In Cuba since July 1954 - continued outstanding performance - adept at recruiting agents. Also been a valuable deep cover agent handler.

CROZIER

- 18 April 1957 - Memo states Noemayo (Valivada) ordered by Station to leave Cuba - an indigenous member of his agent net killed by Cuban authorities. Left Havana 18 Feb. 1957 - went to Costa Rica. To remain there with his family until about 6 May 1957 when he will be reassigned Cuba or another area.
- Jan. 1957 - Recommended changed from contract to career agent. Contract approved. 31 May 1957 - (James Roland notations)
- 1 May 1958 - Contract amended re: allowances - applicable to Mexico City assignment. Duties - Case officer for Communist Party operations in Mexico. Division officer - R. N. Dahlgren. co/L. D. Puckett
- 20 Aug 1958 - Letter of commendation from C. B. Cabell, Crozier's General, USAF - Deputy Director for Noemayo's initiative, resourcefulness & courage infiltration Castro forces in ^{Sierra Maestra} Cuba in March 1958. Also received bonus of \$300 - requested by J. B. Brady, Chief WH/III/Mexico.
- 20 Feb. 1960 - Contracting Officer L. D. Puckett
- 7 June 1961 - Physically qualified for departmental duties only.
