- 1) Phillips resigned his position as staff agent before going into Cuba in 1958.
- 2) Phillips' cover in Cuba was as a proprietor of a television programming business in Havana.
- 3) There was concern in late 1959 that Phillips' cover had been blown. The people in Cuba who allegedly knew of his CIA connections

4. Phillips is classified as "former
witting collaborator (relation-
ship terminated)."

5. Phillips arrived [in Cuba in
[August 1959.] He spent part of
the months of September and
October, 1959, on special
assignment [in ¹⁶⁻¹⁷Venezuela.]

6. Phillips was chief of station in
[the ¹⁶⁻¹⁰Dominican Republic] and
in ¹⁶⁻¹⁷Venezuela.]

7. In 1973 Phillips became Chief
of the Western Hemisphere Division.

8. An annual fitness report for the
period of 6/63 to 3/64 says that
Phillips was in charge of
Cuban operations in Mexico
City. Phillips supervised two
intelligence officers and one
clerk/steno. His duties were:

- a. coordination of reporting on Cuban targets;
- b. recruitment and handling of FI/CI agent personnel in relation to Cuban targets;
- c. direction of a major part of the covert action aimed at Cuban targets in Mexico.
