Subject: Article alleging LHO was interviewed by CIA employees

1. 2/22/64 Northern Va. Sun article alleges that "State Dept. records show that O had several mtgs. with the CIA rep. in the US Embassy in Moscow. ~~During this period~~ ... One State Dept. cable, No. 234, dated 11/2/59, reports that O was interviewed by the CIA & other embassy officials."

2. Allegation is completely unfounded as follows:

a. Article cites S.D. "cable" No. 234, dated 11/2/59 - must mean S.D. despatch No. 234, dated 11/2/59.

b. "Despatch contains no statement or inference that Richard E. Snyder, the 2nd Secy. of the U.S. Embassy in Moscow, who talked w/O on 31 Oct. 1959, has CIA connection. S's name is the only name of a person who might have spoken w/O."

c. Richard E. Snyder (DPOB: 10 Dec. 1919, Passaic, N.J.)

applied for employ in 6/49 & submitted complete PHS form.

Entered on 11/8/49 at GS-9; acc. to Personnel file, was

assigned to OPC & slated to serve in <sup>13-3</sup> [Tokyo] (file doesn't

show he served there). Served in [Heidelberg] 3/50 until

resigning eff. 9/26/50 to assume position w/ HICOG.

No further entries in Personnel file.

of his SA position -> IO req. & need liaison clear. from OS.
