security file #262 622 relating

Nosenko. In addition to the 18
volumes, various unnumbered
files relating to site plans for the
various safe sites used in this
case and admin files relating to
expenses incurred & other miscellaneous
items were also reviewed.

As a result, reviews the attached
docs were located which make
mention of Nosenko's being debriefed
concerning LHO. Add'lly, a 11 March
64 memo from District Field Office
LDFO was located giving a
summary of info which Nosenko
provided DFO personnel during
casual conversation. One of the
items in this memo is the lengthy
discussion of Nosenko's knowledge
of LHO.

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Nosenko complained repeatedly
that he was being photographed &
monitored. Said he heard the
cameras clicking.

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~~at that time~~ one time became very emotional saying he was misunderstood, really wants to remain in US.

Nosenko was questioned on:

- 1) why, KGB did not do certain things such as run an investigation on LHO, check into his marine experience etc
- 2) why, he had said at one time that LHO was a poor shot and on another occasion said he was a good marksman
- 3) on interest org. + extent to which serves a KGB cover, KGB emergency war plans, + extent to which these plans were activated during Cuban missile crisis
- 4) processing of LHO visa (said was done in normal manner + that KGB had copy of visa application. Said Russian Embassy since 1960 have authority to issue visas in 3 to 5 days after application. Said LHO applied orally + late in writing for Sov. citizenship. Copy of written request went to KGB. Copy of it was sent to Supreme Soviet after LHO slashed his wrists. KGB studied reports prepared by Case officer KRUZNOF + decided LHO not normal so of no interest to KGB + not desirable for Sov. citizenship. ^{File 7-110} ~~SECRET~~ to Minsh because this was to live + work
