In May, 1962, William Harvey took over as case officer.

Harvey reported contacts with Roselli during November and December 1967 and January, 1968

6 June 1975 - memo by Stanton F. Ence, D.D. of Security re

testimony of James P. O'Connell before S. S. C. O'Connell remembered \$55,000 passed in a Miami at Florida Shores Motel, M. B. Ence says it was only \$10,000. Unclear whether money was for bugging operation in Las Vegas (via Ed Dubois, former FBI, now M.B. private det.) or Castro assassination attempt.

William P. Curtain (now SAE, L.A. FBI) was with O'Connell at the time.

O'Connell says funds may also have come through John D. Noble, Security Officer of Project [JM/ARE] in Miami.

Money went to either Roselli or Verona

~~30 May 1975~~ F.O.: (undated):

- Re meeting with Meheu 28 April 1967 at Desert Club, L.A. Meheu advised that Roselli and Morgan had both been in Las Vegas in March of this year. Jim Garrison was also in town and it was Meheu's recollection that these individuals spent some time together. Meheu said Jack Anderson had "more than a passing acquaintance with Ed Morgan and that Morgan had "close relationship" with Pat Coyne, both former FBI (Coyne on National Security Council)

3 Sept. 76 - Cuban contacts re FBI request:

Juan Orta - DOB 28 May 1906, Cuba, wife & children in Miami (Orta-Cordova)

Tony Verona - 25 Nov 1908, Cuba, (when J.O. not successful in Castro mission, S.T. suggested T.V.)

Roselli contacted T.V. in Miami circa 1962-63, T.V. then son-in-law to assist him.

"Maceo" - aka Garcia Gomez and Godoy. Cuban who spoke Catalan.

Other Roselli contacts: Robert A. Mahan, Silvestre Biancane, Santor Trafficante, Joseph Shimon (with Roselli, Mahan & Biancane during Verona op in Miami in 1961); Edward P. Moran (later briefed by Mahan & Roselli on ops.)

30 Oct. 67 - memo to FBI Samuel Rapich re meeting of Roselli with Sheffield Edwards and photo of woman and child re "Roselli's true identity" (?)

24 July 75 - re Trafficante - meeting in Miami in September 1960 with Mahan & Biancane re S.T. delivering poison pills "to the agents" who has access to Castro.

9 Aug. 76 - background report on J.R. - used by the Agency in ops re Castro assassination from September 1960 through February 1963.

9 Dec. 1970 - In August 1960, Richard Binell went to Sheffield Edwards of Off of Sec. re assets for Castro op. DCI approved. J.C. King briefed. IMWAVE officials not told. Certain TSD and Commo personnel in initial stages, not letting Mahan told J.R. \$150,000 offered by "international business firms" meeting with "Sam" and "Joe" at Fontanebleau 25 Sept. 1960. - Sam suggested Juan Orta, in Castro's govt. Poison pills delivered to J.O. then T.V., but never "exploited" and after Bay of Pigs "the pills were returned."

22 May 1975 - Letter in response to question from SSCI
from Charles W. Kane, D.S.:

As of November, 1963, James Walter McCord Jr.
was serving in []. Mr. McCord was so assigned
from June 1962 to June 1964.

As of November, 1963, Everett Howard Hunt
was assigned to [], however, apparently
Mr. Hunt had collateral duties with [].
Mr. Hunt was assigned to such tasks
from November, 1961 to February, 1965.
Neither Mr. Hunt nor Mr. McCord were in
charge of Mexican operations at the time
of the Kennedy assassination.

26 Dec 1968 - Roselli calls J. O'Connell from Wash. Nat.
Say he recently ran into Tony V. after several years,
and had lunch. Tony indicated [blank].
but Roselli did not press him for other details.

11 Dec. 1968 - ^{lunch} meeting between J.O. and Roselli and
Joe Shimon at Gaslight Club. Meeting set up
by Shimon. Roselli said it was "coincidence"
that Garrison and Morgan in Las Vegas at ^{14 MAR}
same time. Garrison was primarily interested ^{↓ '6}
in gambling and female companionship. (Jim Phelan
Shimon a former Metro Police Inspector) ^{also with J. re SEP article '6}

11 Dec. 1967 - Harold Osborn, D.S. ~~letter~~ memo re Harvey meeting
re Roselli - met at Madison Hotel on 26 Nov. 67
(Roselli under indictment on \$400,000 Friars Club con)
Harvey upset about not being informed of O'Connell
and Evans' contacts with Roselli.
Roselli revealed names of Philippe Sacco.
