security & other gov't policies.
I believe you will find that this intention
was being implemented."

On 12 January we received a House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) request for documents under a cover memo from OLC. OLC had assigned action to us on items #23, 30, 31, 34 and 35. In subsequent conversation w/ OLC I suggested that DDO be assigned the action on items 29, 30 and 34. OLC agreed.

Item # 31 (Pat - assassination communication between former DCI Dulles and the CIA) is very broad since it covers all correspondence for the period

~~1963 - January 1969~~ ^{1963 - January 1969} I briefly reviewed these files and found nothing that appeared to be of interest to the HSCA. They do not contain a file on the Warren Commission.

The files do contain copies of correspondence between AWD and the Agency and therefore I have made a brief summary of the files and attached it at Tab A. I then did a search of ER index for material in Executive Registry files either received from AWD or addressed to him for the same period. Copies of extracts of this material are included in Tab A.

On item # 35 (report for DCI/ Mr. Conrad's appearance before the Warren Commission) I reviewed all

I reviewed the shelf list on the Dulles files in the ER custody and identified those files that pertain to the 1963 - January 1969 period.

list on the McCone files in ER cabinets
and then recalled individual files
which fell into the 1963-1964 period.
The McCone files do not contain
a file on the Warren Comm'n. I
did not find any material concern-
ing preparation for DCI McCone's
appearance before the Comm'n. I
did find a transcript of a 12 May
1964 telephone conversation between
DCI/McCone & Mr. Rankin, General
Counsel for the Committee on Assassina-
tion asking the DCI to appear before
the Committee the following week. A
copy is attached at Tab-B. Also at
Tab-B are two miscellaneous memo-
randa which might be of interest.

I am told ... that OSC handled
the Agency contact w/ the Comm'n
so they would probably be the best
bet.

I have also reviewed the Executive
Registry files on the Warren
Comm'n and on the Garrison investi-
gation. They contain nothing on the
preparation of the DCI for his appearance
before the Commission. However, they
are available in ER if you wish to
see them.
