
Dear Mr. Chairman:

In keeping with the smaller staff than had been originally planned for the Committee, I realize that it has been necessary to eliminate certain positions. I was surprised when I learned that the position which I now hold was one that had been eliminated.

I am sure you realize, Mr. Chairman, that having been the first person employed by the Committee after its creation last year, this step is not taken without considerable regret on my part. 


