GRAFT AND CORRUPTION

Deputy United States Marshal LARRY DAILEY, Federal Building, Lake Charles, Louisiana, and Deputy Sheriff ALBERT MANUEL, Calcasieu Parish Sheriff's Office, both advised the findings of the Federal Grand Jury at [redacted] in [redacted] concerning possible involvement [redacted]

[redacted] was reportedly submitted to the Department of Justice for review and analysis. [redacted] a well-known gambler in the [redacted] area who was active in the late 1940s, was tried in Federal Court, New Orleans, Louisiana, in [redacted] Federal Grand Jury when he testified that [redacted]

[redacted] Since that period gambling and other vice violations have been rigidly enforced by the Calcasieu Parish Sheriff's Office, and there is presently no graft or corruption in this area.
