CLIP advised on 9/5/61 that at 10:00 a.m., 9/5/61, he, CLIP, was telephonically contacted by PETE LENTINE, who said "what the hell are you trying to do?" and then LENTINE hung up. CLIP said he did not know the significance of or the reason why LENTINE made such a call.

CLIP described LENTINE as an employee of ANTHONY DORIA and HOFFA. LENTINE is Business Agent for a Local of the Allied Industrial Workers Union.
