Inasmuch as subject is being contacted under the TECIP program and since there is no indication that subject is currently involved in any known illegal activity, the Anti-Racketeering case is being retained in a P\* status.

In addition to the information as set forth in the report furnished on 9/30/70, by NO 1283-PC, this source also furnished the following information which due to the singular nature of the information is being included in the Administrative Section:

On 9/30/70, source advised that Mrs. FRANCES PECORA who is a member of the State Insurance Board, voted favorably on a recent rate increase for the insurance industry in the State of Louisiana. Source said that in return for this favorable vote, Mrs. PECORA was able to obtain a loan for \$225,000 from an unnamed insurance company or companies in Baton Rouge, La., to finance the acquisition of the building at 300 Decatur St., New Orleans, La. This building at 300 Decatur St., is a large apartment building in a very expensive section of New Orleans known as the French Quarter.
