ATLAS said that he has known the subject on a fairly close basis except for the last three years. He said he would not classify TOURINE a top echelon hoodlum and explained this statement by saying that some years ago, he (ATLAS) made a real killing with a bookmaker in NYC and was owed a huge sum of money. The bookmaker refused to pay the PCI and so the difficulty was resolved at the conference table. PCI was represented by the subject. In spite of this, TOURINE did not have sufficient influence to obtain the money for the PCI. PCI added that he is of the opinion that if TOURINE was regarded as a top echelon hoodlum, he could have forced the bookmaker to come up with the money.
