Attached for the Jacksonville, Miami, and Tampa Offices are two Xerox copies of a 4 x 6 index card concerning JIM CARTER. This card was voluntarily furnished the Kansas City Office on 12/10/65 by RAYMOND R. HUSTED who at that time was working in "Minutemen" Headquarters at Norborne, Missouri. His identity should be concealed. This card was one of approximately 400 which was being discarded due to a consolidation of their files.

It would appear that the name "JIM CARTER" may be an alias for someone residing at 210 South Lake Barton Road, Orlando, Florida.

The card indicates CARTER recruited into the "Minutemen" by #35151. A card for WILBERT C. WATT, which was also obtained, indicates his "Minutemen" identification number is #35151. No card bearing the name CHARLES SMITH could be located.

A list of these cards are being prepared and will be furnished to appropriate offices in the near future.
