ADMINISTRATIVE

By a communication dated August 8, 1958, Dallas was furnished with a summary of information in this case and requested to make contact with informants in an effort to develop information of value.

By a communication dated August 20, 1958, Dallas furnished the following information developed by SA ROBERT H. BARRETT:

The following informants and potential criminal informants who are acquainted with BARNES and POPE were contacted on the designated times without results concerning burglary at Natchez, Mississippi:

- DL 90 C, contacted 8/12/58
- PCI JACQUELYN ANN DAVIS, was contacted 8/12/58
- PCI MARILYN JANE MILLER, was contacted 8/11/58
- DL 83 C, contacted 8/14/58
- PCI LELON L. BENTLEY, contacted 8/14/58

On August 11, 1958, DL 95 C advised that he had recently been in very close contact with both BARNES and POPE. BARNES admitted to this informant his involvement in the burglary at Natchez, Mississippi, but stated "they got the wrong man" referring to POPE. POPE told the informant on August 10, 1958.

that he was not involved in the burglary at Hatches although he had committed numerous burglaries throughout the United States. POPE was very perturbed over being arrested for a burglary he had not committed.

GI advised that DOROTHY CHRISTA LAMBSON, POPE's girl friend, had left Dallas shortly after the arrest of POPE, BARKER, and LAMBSON on July 16, 1958, after the Hatches burglary. However, LAMBSON recently contacted POPE through GI and called from phone number 3746J, Heberly, Missouri. In view of this, an information copy is being furnished the St. Louis Office which may be requested in the future by New Orleans to conduct investigation re LAMBSON.

For the information of St. Louis, POPE is a top local hoodlum of the Dallas Office, and a close associate of BARKER. BARKER, POPE and LAMBSON were arrested 7/16/58 at Garland, Texas, by local authorities on information furnished by Hatches, Mississippi, that BARKER had been identified as one of two burglars of a apartment in Hatches on July 13, 1958. It was believed by the authorities that POPE was BARKER's associate. New Orleans had requested Dallas to make inquiry of informants to determine if they had any knowledge which might be of assistance in this case as the Dallas authorities had advised they do not have sufficient evidence to extradite BARKER, POPE, and LAMBSON from Dallas. All three are presently free on bond.

For further information of New Orleans, a fingerprint card for LAMBSON was obtained from the Dallas PD 7/22/58 and forwarded to the FBI Identification Division on July 23, 1958.

On July 29, 1958, the FBI Identification Division advised that LAMBSON had no prior criminal record, and the original prints have been returned to the Dallas PD.

SA 95 G also advised that he was sure POPE was not involved in the instant burglary as POPE had to borrow money recently from his mother to make bond.

SA 95 G stated he would attempt to ascertain the identity of BARKER's associate and furnish name to the FBI Office Dallas. If name is obtained, it will be forwarded immediately Dallas.

On July 16, 1958, POPE was arrested with RACK WALTER BARNES, was, FBI #669305, and POPE's girl friend, DOROTHY ONEYLA LAMSDON, described only as a white female, age 18, at Garland, Texas, by local authorities, on a warrant outstanding in Hatcher, Texas, charging all three with burglary of a supermarket there on July 13, 1958. LAMSDON was released on a writ, prior to the obtaining of a complete description. However, she was fingerprinted. The prints were forwarded to the FBI Identification Division, which subsequently advised she had no prior criminal arrest record. Information from informants is that BARNES was involved in the burglary, but that POPE and LAMSDON were not. POPE was recently convicted in Dallas for narcotics possession, and received a three-year sentence. He is presently free on appeal bond, awaiting disposition of the Mississippi burglary charge.

On August 11, 1958, BU-95-C advised that after her release, LAMSDON returned to her residence in Hoberly, Missouri. She has remained in contact with POPE through CI's phone, and CI determined she has called POPE from Hoberly through CI's phone, and CI advised he had been unable to determine exact identity of BARNES' accomplice in Hatcher burglary, but from exact things said by POPE, BARNES, and their associates, CI is of strong opinion that the accomplice was JAMAIL LEE CARTER, was, FBI Number: 1476686, another Top Local hoodlum of the Dallas Office (Dallas File 92-150).

St. Louis at Hoberly, Missouri, will obtain background information, photograph and description of DOROTHY ONEYLA LAMSDON, and ascertain all available information concerning relationship between LAMSDON and POPE. If feasible, will consider interview of EIGHT, if same can be conducted without endangering identity of -95-C. If interviewed, will attempt to obtain all available information about POPE's activities. Will keep possible NSFA violation in mind while conducting above investigation.
