SUBJECT: Alpha 66 (U)

(P) A reliable source received the following information from Antonio
VECIANA on 16 January 1963:

A. Alpha 66 (the cover name for the second front of Escambray)
had eight (8) commando type actions planned to take place during the next
60 days. Raids will be made by five (5) man commando parties. Two (2)
of the men will be demolitions men.

B. Alpha 66 has ordered twelve (12) fiberglass, 18 ft, boats with
145 horsepower inboard motors from a Miami firm. Cost of each boat, with
motors, is \$2,000.00. Alpha 66 has taken delivery on three (3) boats.
Remaining nine (9) boats to be delivered within the next 45 days.

C. Alpha 66 has: 1,000 lbs of C-3 explosives, with enough time-fuze
pencils for the amount of explosives, 60 submachine guns, 40 machine guns
and 400 hand grenades.

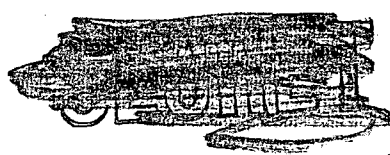
