SUBJECT: Completion of Training Report on ANCLATTER-1, Training Alias:  
MSMILLIE.

REF : Memorandum for Director of Training; Attention: Chief, Covert

of ANCLATTER-1 (201-25168); From WH Division dated 6 July 1964.

1. ANCLATTER-1 received covert training in New York from  
20 July through 21 August 1964. There was no substantial variance  
in the curriculum as outlined in the original request.

2. Throughout the entire training period ANCLATTER-1 appeared  
attentive, serious, and anxious to absorb as much as he could of  
the training material. Although not particularly bright, he tried  
hard and was able to grasp and put to practical use the principles  
of tradecraft, elicitation, and agent handling and management.

3. On his own time ANCLATTER-1 devoted many hours to casing  
and laying out plans for dead drops and personal meetings, which  
in almost all cases were excellent. Although rough in the begin-  
ning, his efforts to achieve good results were rewarded by dint of  
his ability to concentrate on the job at hand and do the best pos-  
sible job under the circumstances.

4. On ANCLATTER-1's one surveillance exercise he performed  
very well and submitted one of the best reports ever prepared by a  
student. His excellent report, however, was the result of comitt-  
ting his one big fault which was the very obvious way in which he  
took notes throughout the exercise.

5. ANCLATTER-1 worked hard at reporting, and after a somewhat  
shaky start, proved able to write passably although his command of  
English is limited. His contact reports were excellent and his  
information reports fair. In face to face situations, involving  
unwilling informants and "agents", ANCLATTER-1 performed very well.  
His interest in securing as much detail as possible in the short  
time allotted for the exercises was commendable, although on occas-  
ions he appeared to be carried away by his own enthusiasm which  
resulted in a hurried approach to an agent who under the circum-  
stances might very well have held up for work. ANCLATTER-1 accepted  
adverse criticism in this matter and now realizes his mistakes.


