ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

1. THE POSTPONEMENT OF AELADLE'S DEBRIEFING BY THE GERMAN REPRESENTATIVES HAS AFFORDED US A BREATHING SPELL OF WHICH WE WOULD LIKE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE BY ASKING YOU A FEW QUESTIONS. WE UNDERSTAND FROM CARSON AND NEMETH THAT AELADLE WAS SCHEDULED TO BE SURFACED IN THE NEAR FUTURE AND THAT THIS WOULD HAVE A GREAT IMPACT ON MOST NATO COUNTRIES. DO YOU INTEND TO DISCUSS THE SURFACING WITH THE GERMANS IF AND WHEN THEY COME TO WASHINGTON. IF NOT, WOULD YOU BE KIND ENOUGH TO GIVE US SUFFICIENT FORWARNING OF THE IMPENDING SURFACING INCLUSIVE OF SCENARIO AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION, TO ENABLE US TO ENGAGE IN INFORMATIVE DISCUSSIONS WITH OUR LIAISON PARTNERS, BOTH GERMAN AND AMERICAN. IT WOULD ENHANCE OUR POSITION WITH OUR GERMAN LIAISON PARTNERS IF WE WERE ABLE TO ANSWER MOST OF THE QUESTIONS WHICH MIGHT ARISE FROM PUBLIC STATEMENTS MADE BY AELADLE EVEN IF THEY CONCERN COUNTRIES AND MATTERS NOT OF IMMEDIATE CONCERN TO WEST GERMANY PER SE.
2. EXPERIENCE HAS TAUGHT US, FOR INSTANCE, THAT PRESS UTTERANCES BY HIGH LEVEL DEFECTORS WILL PROMPT DCSI AND EVEN CINCUSAREUR TO REQUEST BACKGROUND AND OTHER INFORMATION FROM CHIEF OF STATION, GERMANY. IF POSSIBLE WE WOULD LIKE TO BE ABLE TO REPRESENT OUR HEADQUARTERS IN A KNOWLEDGEABLE MANNER -- USAREUR SELDOM RELIES ON ACSI.
3. AN EARLY ANSWER WOULD BE MUCH APPRECIATED.
