ANTI-FRENCH CASTRO ACTIVITIES
INTERNAL SECURITY - CUBA

On January 8, 1963, a confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that he had learned that Jose Airo Cardona, Head of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, an anti-Castro organization, was in Washington, D. C., and desired to see Gonzalo Facio, Costa Rican Ambassador to the United States.

The informant later learned that Facio had contacted Cardona and had advised him that Juan Bosch, President-elect of the Dominican Republic, is "taking the same line we have." Facio and Cardona, according to the informant, agreed to a further discussion to take place on January 9, 1963.

The position of Gonzalo Facio was verified through the "Diplomatic List", dated November, 1962, published by the United States Department of State.
